I would like to take this opportunity to thank MDC for the invitation to judge and to all exhibitors for their entries.

#### **Minor Puppy Dog – 5(1)**

1. Hickling's Evaluesco Ego Boost. 8 month black and rust, very mature for his age. Short coupled with gently sloping topline to correct croup and tailset. Correct angulation front and rear creating a square profile outline. Ample forechest and depth of brisket for age. Strong head but balanced with deep muzzle and dark almond eye. Moved well when settled BPD
2. Brough and Brannan's Supeta's Miami Heat for Aniraz. 6 month black and rust. Lovely boy but giving his handler a hard time which cost him the class today. Strong balanced head with length and depth of muzzle, the darkest of almond shaped eye. Good reach of neck into correctly placed shoulders, gently sloping topline to correct croup and tailset. Straight front with tightest of feet, brisket not to elbow but this will come with maturity. Moved well when settled.
3. Moore's Tuwos National Hero (IKC)

#### **Puppy Dog – 6(0)**

1. We bb and Mullins' Protocol's The Midas Touch (Imp USA). 10 ½ month black and rust. Short coupled with ample forechest, brisket let down to elbow. Gently sloping topline into correct croup and tailset. Lovely reach of neck into correctly placed shoulders, straight front with tight feet. His movement won the class, true coming towards and away with topline held in profile.
2. Evans' Amazon Showtime – 10 ½ month black and rust. Another short coupled boy with adequate forechest and good depth of brisket. Correct angulation front and rear with gently sloping topline held on the move. Gorgeous balanced head with length and depth of muzzle and the darkest of eye. Just lost out on his front movement.

### **Junior Dog – 2(0)**

1. Wilson's Pursang Shimmy Shimmy Ya – 18 month brown and rust, very mature boy creating lovely square profile with ample forechest and depth. Correct shoulder placement with gently sloping topline, correct turn of stifle and good second thigh. Straight front with tight feet, moved well when settled. Would prefer a more balanced head with more length of muzzle and better head planes.
2. Cappell's Llepac Against All The Odds – 17 month black and rust. Really liked this boy just lost out on maturity today. Beautiful balanced head with length and depth of muzzle, could put a ruler on his head planes. Darkest of almond shaped eye. Adequate forechest and depth of brisket, good reach of neck into gently sloping topline held on the move. Straight front with tight feet, moved with ease and drive.

### **Yearling Dog – 4(1)**

1. Fletcher's Sacaria Whisper of Hope – I loved this boy and seriously considered him for the CC, just feel he needs more time to fully come into his own. 21 month brown and rust, square profile with lovely reach of neck into correctly placed shoulders. Adequate forechest and depth of brisket to elbow, straight front with tight feet. Good turn of stifle and second thigh. Pleasing balanced head with level head planes and good length and depth of muzzle, dark eye for a brown. Moved true both coming towards and away. Shown really well, pleased to award him the RCC
2. Hart's Supeta's Scorchio – 17 month brown and rust. Well off for bone and substance and very mature for age. Strong balanced head with length and depth of muzzle, dark eye for a brown. Straight front to tight feet, strong topline held on the move. Moved well

### **Novice Dog – 4(0)**

1. Evans' Amazon Showtime
2. Moore's Tuwos National Hero (IKC) – 6 month black and rust, lovely boy but still very much a baby. Correct angulation front and rear, good depth of brisket for age. Balanced head with dark eye, moved well.
3. Jefferies' Shalissa's The Godfather

### **Under Graduate Dog – 4(2)**

1. Griffiths' Korifey Axl at Amious – 11 ½ month black and rust. Standard boy with square profile outline, lovely forechest and depth of brisket. Correct angulation front and rear, sloping topline held on the move. Balanced head with darkest of eye. Moved well.
2. Kent, Kent and Sutton Korifey Reckless – 11 ½ month black and rust, litter brother to first place although different in type. Preferred head of first place. Straight front into tightest of feet, gently sloping topline held on the move. Adequate forechest, lacking in depth of brisket at the moment. Moved well.

### **Post Graduate Dog – 2(0)**

1. Evans' Lateagain Heart of Fire JW – Black and rust, standard square boy. Prominent forechest with good depth of brisket. Correct angulation front and rear, straight front into tightest of feet. Pleasing head with darkest of eye. Moved ok
2. Wright's Kitado Ever So Funky – Brown and rust. Different in type to my first place, whose forechest and depth I preferred. Nice balanced head with dark eye for a brown. Moved ok

### **Limit Dog – 8(3)**

1. Seward's Teuschons The Fierce Knight with Elleonia JW – Black and rust. This boy stood out in this class for me, I was so disappointed when he seemed to fall flat in the challenge. Very smart standard boy with lovely forechest and brisket down to elbow. Good reach of neck into correct lay of shoulder and gently sloping topline. Balanced head with darkest of eye. Could not fault his movement in the class, true coming towards and away, moving with ease and drive.
2. Plowman's Supeta's Pocketful of Glory JW – Standard black and rust boy very similar in type to first place with a lot of the same attributes that I like, just felt that today he was slightly out moved in the class. Stronger head than first place but balanced with dark eye, adequate forechest and deep brisket, correct angulation front and rear.
3. Young's Krieger's Hunky Dory at Malibray

### **Open Dog – 4(2)**

1. McLaren's Aritaur Invincible at Teuschon – Standard black and rust boy, not over done in anyway just an all round honest dog.  
Square profile outline with ample forechest and correct turn of stifle with good second thigh. Correct lay of shoulder with gently sloping topline held on the move. Straightest of fronts into tight feet. Balanced head with level head planes and darkest of almond shaped eye. He came into his own on the move, true towards and away moving with drive. Sympathetically handled to his best advantage, I just couldn't deny him the CC in the challenge and then BIS. DCC and BIS
2. Wedgbury's Manzart War Emblem – Black and rust. Another lovely standard boy I just preferred the head of first place. Square profile outline with gently sloping topline, correct angulation front and rear. Straight front with tight feet. Moved and shown really well.

### **Champion Dog – 2(0)**

1. Jones and Ushakova's CH Korifey Vanquish JW – What a showman and a worthy champion. Black and rust standard boy with ample forechest and depth of brisket. Correct angulation front and rear creating square profile. Good reach of neck into gently sloping topline, held on the move. Balanced head with dark eye. Covered the ground with ease.
2. Robinson's CH/LUX & NI CH Korifey Ivan ShCEX – Different type to first place and steeper topline than I prefer. Black and rust. Straight front into tight feet, balanced head with dark eye. Moved well.

### **Veteran Dog – 5(3)**

1. Lafford and Groves Lateagain Satisfaction JW ShCEx – 7 year old standard black and rust, still looking good for his age. Correct angulation front and rear creating square profile. Ample forechest and correct turn of stifle, gently sloping topline held on the move. Pleasing balanced head. Straight front with tight feet. Moved well.
2. Morgan's Malibray Rhuvaal at Telenndu ShCM VW – 8 year old black and rust. Longer in loin than first place and therefore not creating the square profile that I prefer. Correct angulation front and rear. Balanced head with level head planes. Moved ok.
3. Kuhl's Lux CH Holyhell's Blue Steel JW (Imp SRB)

### **Minor Puppy B\*tch – 9(4)**

1. Pollard's Shalissa's Hot Toddy at Whizzbean – What an absolute star, she never stopped showing, loved this pup. 6 ½ month black and rust. Prettiest of heads, balanced skull to muzzle with level head planes, dark almond eye. Lovely reach of neck into correctly placed shoulders, gently sloping topline, correct croup and tailset. Adequate forechest and depth of brisket to elbow, straight front to tight feet. Correct turn of stifle with good second thigh. Moved really well both coming towards, away and in profile. Please to award her BPB and BPIS, will watch her show career with interest.
2. Mycroft's Imidz Lady Melody of Supeta – Another lovely puppy and unlucky to meet first place. 6 month brown and rust. Gorgeous head, well balanced with length and depth of muzzle, level head planes, dark eye. Correct angulation front and rear with straight front, would prefer tighter feet. Adequate forechest and depth of brisket for age. Moved well.

### **Puppy B\*tch – 4(0)**

1. Merrett's Korifey Sweet Child of Mine JW – 11 ½ month black and rust, stylish puppy handled very well. Correct angulation front and rear. Nice reach of neck into gently sloping topline held on the move. Straight front with tight feet. Balanced pretty head with dark eye. Moved well.
2. Bradbury and Sanderson Jodaseen Steel City Blues – Close decision between first and second, just preferred the reach of neck of first place. 8 month black and rust. Correct angulation front and rear, adequate forechest and good depth of brisket. Straight front into tight feet. Balanced head with dark eye, moved well
3. Burnham's Jodaseen All Of My Heart

### **Junior B\*tch – 3(0)**

1. Tant's Rafthouse Bundlebrent at Granadeya – 14 month substantial but elegant brown and rust. Strong but feminine head, good width, length and depth of muzzle, dark eye for a brown. Lovely reach of neck into firm, gently sloping topline. Straight front with the tightest of feet, adequate forechest with brisket let down to elbow. Correct angulation front and rear with good turn of stifle and second thigh. Moved true away and towards. Such a shame that she did not show as well in the challenge.
2. Robertson's Cockneyoka Love Over Gold -17 month brown and rust. Different type to first place and looking very rangy at the moment and not the square profile I prefer. Became more animated when handler started to use bait. Just enough forechest and depth of brisket for height. Head ok. Moved really well, true both towards and away.
3. Balshaw's Cockneyoka Over The Line

### **Yearling B\*tch - 4(0)**

1. Evans' Amazon She Is Adored – 17 month brown and rust. Smart square profile, strong gently sloping topline held on the move. Lovely reach of neck into well laid shoulders, adequate forechest and depth of brisket . Correct angulation front and rear with good turn of stifle and second thigh. Straight front into tight feet. Pretty balanced head with equal length of skull to muzzle creating blunt wedge, dark almond shaped eye. Moved really well true both towards and away. This girl really came into her own in the challenge where she caught my eye and I couldn't deny her the CC. CC, RBIS and BOS
2. Kuhl's Newfords Deja Vu – 18 month brown and rust. Another lovely brown girl. Square profile, adequate forechest and brisket to elbow. Correct angulation front and rear, with gently sloping topline held on the move. Well balanced head with dark eye. Moved well.
3. Marflow's Teuschons Mirror Force

### **Novice B\*tch – 4(1)**

1. Kuhl's Newfords Deja Vu
2. Pollard's Shalissa's Hot Toddy at Whizzbean
3. Hutchison's Debison's Excuse My French

### **Under Graduate B\*tch – 6(1)**

1. Mycroft & Kelly's Supeta's Smokin Hot – Smart square black and rust. Correct angulation front and rear, gently sloping topline held on the move. Strong but feminine and balanced head, darkest of eyes. Moved well
2. Pollard's Shalissa's Hot Toddy at Whizzbean
3. Balshaw's Cockneyoka Over The Line

### **Graduate B\*itch - 3(2)**

1. Lafford's Lateagain Wild Heart avec Sariandobes – Flashy brown and rust handled really well. Good reach of neck into correctly placed shoulder and gently sloping topline. Depth of brisket to elbow. Straight front, tightest of feet, good turn of stifle and second thigh. Level head planes and nice length of muzzle, would prefer more underjaw. Moved well.

### **Post Graduate B\*itch - 1(1)**

#### **Limit B\*tch - 4(1)**

1. Evans' Amazon Just Let Me Adore You – Smart black and rust, lovely reach of neck into well placed shoulder, gently sloping topline held on the move. Adequate forechest and depth of brisket to elbow. Good turn of stifle and second thigh. Straight front with tight feet. Balanced head with dark eye and level head planes. Moved and shown well.
2. Gallagher's Izralight Jitterbug – Brown and rust, bigger girl than first place and not as clean in profile. Lovely forechest and good depth of brisket. Correct angulation front and rear. Head ok. Moved well.
3. Wedgebury's Manzart Xtra Special

#### **Open B\*itch – 6(2)**

1. Brough's Sharhyste Maid in the Purple for Aniiiraz – Flashy, elegant black and rust. Lovely reach of neck into well placed shoulders, gently sloping topline held on the move. Correct angulation both front and rear, straight front with tight feet. Pretty head with level head planes, would just prefer more underjaw. Moved really well.
2. Hutchison & Mycroft's Supeta's Diamonds Rforever with Debison JW – Different type to first place but still a lovely b\*itch. Black and rust. Standard, square in profile, good depth of brisket and forechest. Straight front into tight feet. Strong but feminine head, moved well.
3. Robinson's Lux CH Vivat De Vinko Vendetta for Korifey (Imp RUS)

#### **Champion B\*tch - 3(2)**

1. Bisland's CH Krieger's Highland Fling – Lovely brown and rust every bit a Champion. Ample forechest and depth of brisket, straight front into tight feet. Long reach of neck into correctly placed shoulders, gently sloping topline held on the move. Good turn of stifle and second thigh. Pretty balanced head with good depth of muzzle. Moved with drive.

#### **Veteran B\*tch – 2(1)**

1. Glennon's Supeta's Red Hot Rocket -9 year old brown and rust. She certainly enjoyed her day out and looks fab for her age. Standard, square profile, straight front. Good angulation front and rear, gently sloping topline held on the move. Balanced head with deep muzzle and dark eye for a brown. Moved really well. BVIS
